#### Wisconsin Regional Art Program Guidelines:

1. Select a workshop and send completed entry blank and a check for \$20.00 to one of the coordinators. Make check out to the sponsoring organization, not the coordinator.
2. The program is open to NONPROFESSIONAL artists and crafters. Artists determine their own status.
3. All work must be ORIGINAL in concept, design and done by the person signing it. Paintings made as copies during a teacher's demonstration are not eligible. Work must have been completed with the past two years. Copies of other artwork, copyrighted photographs or patterns cannot be accepted. No decorated kits are acceptable.
4. A show may be cancelled is less than 20 artists enter. **(Wausau's shows are never cancelled; we consider this an educational experience).** Enter as many regional shows as you wish.
5. All paintings, graphics and photographs must be dry, framed and ready to hang. Please use wire side to side on the back. No tension devices will be accepted in place of frames (they break). (No saw tooth hangers in Wausau). Any wall-hung sculpture or craft must be ready with necessary hanging devices. Carefully pack small or fragile items. UW-MADISON AND THE WORKSHOP SPONSORS ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR DAMAGE OR LOSS OF YOUR WORK. You must provide your own insurance if desired.
6. Enter up to 3 works in ANY media: **Painting** – oil, acrylic, watercolor, mixed. **Graphics** – drawing, prints, pastel. **Sculpture** – any material, mixed media. **Crafts** – clay, wood, metal, fiber, paper. **Photography** – black and white, color, **Digital** – print or photograph. (Some workshops may need to limit the number of entries due to space constraints, (i.e.: 2 pcs).

7. When pricing work, please remember that the exhibit gallery may take a commission on all work sold. This will be listed with each WRAP show exhibit location as to the percentage. (If the Wausau show is at the Center for Visual Arts, the commission take is 33%). (Pricing example for 33% - you need to get \$100.00, you must ask \$150.00 ( $67\% \times \$150.00 = \$100.50$  or multiply the price you want by 150% -  $\$100 \times 150\% = \$150.00$  and you'll be close).
