WISCONSIN VALLEY ART ASSOCIATION: was formed in 1951 with the purpose of promoting the arts, providing lectures, exhibits and art workshops in the area. The WVAA is a non-profit 501c(3) organization open to all interested artists, craftspeople and students, as well as art patrons and enthusiasts. We further art education through scholarships and grants to organizations and individuals. The WVAA funds art education scholarships at the University of Wisconsin-Marathon County, the Center for Visual Arts and the Woodson Art Museum. The WVAA also awards scholarships to individuals who wish to continue their art education. Our Art in the Park festival is held each year at Marathon Park in Wausau. Over 30,000 people attend this two-day art event, held the weekend after Labor Day. We also sponsor two exhibits annually, our own Memorial Art Exhibit and the Wisconsin Regional Arts Program (WRAP) Exhibit. Meetings are held on the third Thursday of each month, except June, July, August and December. Members are provided with a monthly newsletter detailing upcoming programs and events. Youth membership is \$15.00, single membership is \$25.00 and family membership is \$30.00.
