Jackie Michael will be teaching a class in Gel Printing at Wesley United Methodist Church, 1101 Elm Street in Wausau on Wednesday, January 16th from 11a- 3p.

We need a minimum of 6 and a maximum of ten participants. Everyone is welcome and no experience is necessary. The cost is \$30 paid directly to Jackie .

Everything you need will be provided. Gel plates, acrylic paint, a variety of papers, brayers, stencils, and materials to make your own stencils and masks.

If you have and want to bring for your own use: a gel plate, a brayer or a variety of your favorite papers, feel free.

Gel Printing is basically a form of mono printing (meaning you get "one" copy)

I enjoy making a many layered abstract background to paint on or to use in collages although it can be a finished work in it self .

I will provide instructions and a list of materials to make your own homemade gel plate but we WILL NOT be making them in this class .
